BUBBLE FORMATIONS

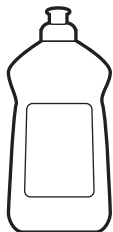
You will need



☐ Water



☐ Glycerine
(available at all
good chemists)



☐ Washing-up
Liquid



☐ Sugar



☐ Pipe
Cleaners

Make Bubble Mixture

Requires Adult Supervision



Find a container to hold your bubble mixture. It's best to choose one that has a lid. This will keep your bubbles fresh and make it easier to mix the solution.



To make the bubble mixture put in the container;

- 2 cups of washing-up liquid
- 4 cups of warm water
- 6 - 8 tablespoons of glycerine
- 2 teaspoons of sugar

The glycerine allows the bubbles to remain intact longer, protecting the water in the bubble formula from evaporating too quickly.



Place the lid on the container and shake your bubbles for one minute to mix well. If you do not have a lid for your container, stir rapidly for one minute.



Now it's time to enjoy blowing bubbles using a bubble wand (see below).

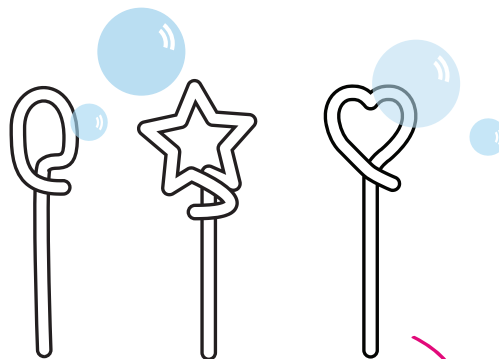
Make a Bubble Wand

Twist a loop in the end of a pipe cleaner and you've got an instant bubble wand.

Or use two pipe cleaners, one for the loop and one for the handle. You can even bend the loop into fun shapes, such as a star or heart.

Other Bubble Wand Suggestions

Flyer Swatter,
Cookie Cutter,
Wire hanger straightened with a loop



Dip the wands into the bubble mixture and blow!

Or you can wave the wand in one direction through the air.
